



## Fuel Surcharge

California's diesel fuel prices are among the highest in the nation. The **California Air Resources Board** mandates the fuel sold in California matches or exceeds Federal Standards due to environmental controls. The fuel is designed to burn more efficient and reduce vehicle emissions, which in turn improves air quality and ultimately public health. Truckers fueling with this fuel must pay higher prices per gallon than the rest of the Nation, which considerably increases operating cost.

The surcharge is based on the **Department of Energy's** diesel fuel price information. For every five cents increase over \$1.35 per gallon, the surcharge will increase 0.5%. Please see percentage table below:
